The Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership officials goes into effect

The Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership (Sustainable CAP) [officially](#) went into effect on April 1, 2023. This agreement has set \$1B in federal programs and activities, and \$2.5B in cost-shared programs and activities funded by federal, provincial, and territorial governments, up 25% from the 2018-2023 agreement.

The Canadian Agricultural Human Resources Council (CAHRC) launches survey to evaluate the post-pandemic labour market situation

An update to the previous study completed in 2018, CAHRC's latest survey will collect insights from primary producers, provincial governments, agricultural industry associations, commodity groups, and other stakeholders in the agriculture industry to identify challenges and explore potential solutions to the agricultural sectors labour market situation. The [survey](#) closes April 28, 2023.

Parliament set to resume sitting

The House of Commons and the Senate are set to resume sitting on April 17 and 18 and will sit for five weeks before recessing for the May long weekend.

At Committee, the Standing Committee on Agriculture and Agri-Food is set to begin wrapping up its study on Food Price Inflation, with Costco Wholesale Canada Ltd. [scheduled](#) to appear on April 17. The Standing Committee on Health is set to resume Clause-by-Clause Consideration of Bill C-252, An Act to amend the Food and Drugs Act (prohibition of food and beverage marketing directed at children), with representatives from the Department of Health [scheduled](#) to appear on April 18.
